Serve the Lord with gladness

As you have heard, we serve the Lord with our time, talent and treasure. The treasures that have been generously given faithfully for generations has made everything that we do through God in this congregation possible. Today I am going to focus on the other two.

People serving joyfully with their time and talents

A fewyears ago I counted all the people in the congregation that were coming to church at least a few times per year. The total was 105 people. 75 of those people still attend at least a few times per year. 15 of those people have passed away. Four have moved away, one started going to a different church some time after the border closed as he lives in Canada, seven stopped coming during COVID and rarely if ever attend currently and three others started going to a different church. Since that time we have added 27 new people who are mostly attending regularly. So we lost 30 and gained 27 sheep for close to breaking even. Of course we would all love to be growing but we can't stop death and COVID presented some unique challenges for many individuals.

Of the total 105 regular worshippers, 78 were active in one or many things either as part of the worship service like reading Scripture, choir, music, puppets, serving communion, signing for the deaf, ushering... or outside of the service like fellowship hour, serving on a committee, taking care of the property at church or at Grace House, Bible Study, Sunday School, bell tower project, VBS, funerals, Mother's Day Tea, altar guild, outreach, counting the offering, decorations, the fall festival, newsletters, insurance management, Cares committee, prayer chain, Wednesday morning Bible School, youth events, pre School, community meals, cookbook fundraiser, Easter breakfast, Easter cross, garden tour, ladies' Christmas party, stewardship Sunday, VBS parade or booth, flowers or various special projects.

Of the current 102 regular worshippers, 74 are active in mostly the same activities so roughly the same percentage although some people pulled back on the amount of time they were serving during COVID and many have not returned to serving at the same levels prior to COVID. We have added a second Sunday service in the afternoon and live streaming of all our worship services. We have also added family dinners once per month.

I am very grateful for all of the people who serve so faithfully and encourage the rest of you to experience the joy of serving your Lord through the various ministries of our congregation. I am also thankful to those of you who serve in so many ways outside of our congregation at the food bank, traveling to Africa for medical mission trips and in your families and communities.

I hope this article gives a little snap shot of now versus a few years ago and gives hope and encouragement that we can be a healthy component of our community for many years to come. The nominating committee has met twice over the last month or so and made phone calls to a variety of these servants about their interest in continued support of all that we do at this congregation. If you would like to help us in some way please call Sandie Miller, Dick Johnson, Pam Markusen or myself. Also, Susie Sanders and Hazel Rutherford have agreed to help us coordinate volunteers moving forward so you may receive a call from them from time to time to see if you are available to help.
